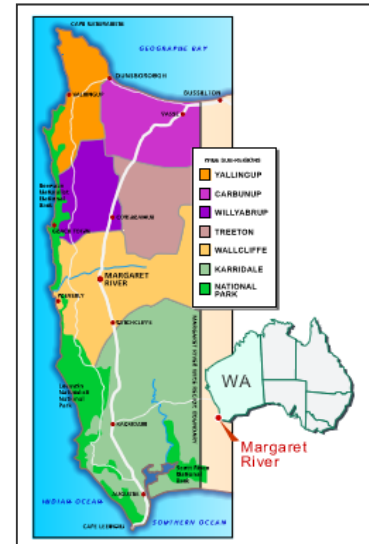
About Margaret River

Margaret River is a name synonymous with quality and consistency. This is well reflected in the fact this small wine region located in Western Australia accounts for just 1.5% of the country's total grape production and a whopping 23% of its premium bottled wine market in sales, and exports widely to Asia, Europe and the US.

Margaret River wines are not your typical Australians. Deemed to be more European in style, they generally offer a rich and intense fruit flavour, but remain elegant, understated, accessible and very easy to drink. Most wines are hand-crafted at small family-run wineries.

These wineries are gaining recognition for the excellence of their Bordeaux-style blends of Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot and Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon as well as their striking Chardonnays and stylish Shirazes.

A perfect match with enthusiasts in Hong Kong who are ready for more sophisticated and palate-pleasing wines, Margaret River produces wines that just perfect for Asian tastes.



Wine Regions of Australia and New Zealand

Western Australia: The Southwest

Margaret River

Surrounded by water on three sides, the beautiful and bountiful Margaret River Wine Region benefits from the slow ripening of its cool-to-warm Maritime Mediterranean climate. Known as "Australia's Bordeaux", the region is noted for the quality and elegance of its Cabernet / Merlot blends, spicy and nuanced Shirazes and vibrant Semillon / Sauvignon Blanc blends and Chardonnays.

Great Southern

The vast Great Southern Wine region is quickly gaining a well-earned international reputation as a producer of consistently high quality and elegant wines. The Mount Barker sub-region, with its cool and elevated slow-ripening characteristics, has plantings dating back to the mid-1960s that render especially finely structured and intense Shirazes, Cabernets and Chardonnays.

South Australia: The Limestone Coast

Coonawarra

A wine region famous for its remarkable "*terra rossa*" red volcanic soil and limestone plateau, Coonawarra is synonymous with classy and rich Cabernet Sauvignon full of plum and blackcurrant fruit. First planted in 1890, the Coonawarra Wine Region enjoys a Mediterranean climate with dry and moderately cool summers.

Padthaway

The Padthaway Wine Region is located less than 100 km north of Coonawarra and, like its more famous neighbour, is marked by a Mediterranean climate and “*terra rossa*” soil. Although Padthaway is dominated by white varieties, especially Chardonnay, the region also produces rich and full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz.

New Zealand: South Island

Marlborough

New Zealand's largest and best known wine-growing area, Marlborough is noted for the distinctive pungency and zesty fruit flavours of its signature Sauvignon Blancs. The free-draining, alluvial loams over gravelly sub-soils in the Wairau and Awatere River valleys provides ideal growing conditions. The area is also marked by its abundant sunshine with cool nights and a long growing season.

Waipara Valley

Located an hour's drive north of Christchurch, the Waipara valley features soils made up of chalky loams that are often rich in limestone. Long, dry summers, abundant sunshine and relatively cool growing conditions produce fruity and vibrant Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noirs. Canterbury is New Zealand's fourth largest wine region.
